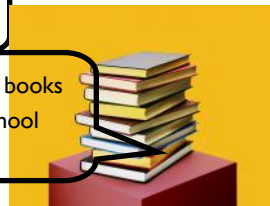

## What to do if your child develops symptoms of coronavirus

If your child is displaying symptoms of coronavirus at home or is sent home by the headteacher with coronavirus symptoms, you must arrange a test for them immediately and inform the school of the result. Children may return if the test result is negative. Please let the headteacher know immediately when you receive the result of your child's coronavirus test by calling the school office on 0207 624 1830

To arrange a test you should visit [nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test](https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test) If your child tests positive for coronavirus, you will receive a text, email or phone call from NHS that explains what your result is and what you need to do next.

Class or year group bubbles within the school will not be closed if there is a child or adult with symptoms—this will only happen if there is a confirmed case

## Procedures in place to keep out school safe:

1. Parents need to call the school office if they have any messages.
2. When dropping off or collecting children, please try to maintain a 2-metre distance or use a mask
3. Be on time for drop-off and pick up
4. Do not let children bring toys or balls from home
5. If your child has a medical need, make sure we know and that we have medication in school
6. Late children will be admitted through the main reception gate at 9a.m. once other children are in class.
7. If you have a concern, please ring the school office and arrange a meeting with the relevant member of staff.
8. If you are visiting the school, you will be asked to sanitise your hands, have temperature check, use a mask and leave your details.
