A message from Fr Terry

As you know by now, places of worship have had to close doors for the next four weeks for collective worship after the decision by Parliament last Wednesday. This means that there will be **no** celebration of the Eucharist in either of our two churches until after December 2nd. I know how painful this is for many people. Many were visibly upset leaving church on Wednesday morning after the last Mass in Quex Road.

However, all is not lost!

We are able to open **Sacred Heart Church** from **10am-11am every morning** for one hour when we will have the opportunity to gather for **silent prayer** before the Blessed Sacrament.

The church of **Immaculate Heart of Mary** will open for an hour of quiet prayer on **Tuesday and Sunday mornings from 10am-11am**.

One of the Parish Team will celebrate Mass every day at Quex Road at 9am. Unfortunately, no members of the public are allowed to join us. The mass will be available to watch on our web camera and you can follow us live on camera at
